As the private and public sectors alike have been undergoing diverse and promising transformational changes, which open the door to exciting new opportunities for emerging women leaders to move into senior executive roles, women themselves have continued to push the boundaries and demonstrated resilience by utilizing their strengths and leadership qualities in skill, knowledge, experience and passion, to thrive, succeed and reach the very top of their career.









However, as distinct genders, women still face specific and different challenges from men as they advance in the workplace. In fact, the very habits that helped women early in their careers hinder them as they move up, according to leadership expert, Sally Helgesen. Across many African countries, available data shows that women have not yet equally taken their place at the top; from national governments, state or provincial governments, to local community groups, women are vastly underrepresented in decision making processes. For instance, an influential report states that women constitute only 24 per cent of the 12,113 parliamentarians in Africa, 25 per cent in the lower houses, and 20 per cent in the upper houses of parliament. Moreover, while local government is often hailed as a training ground for women in politics, the report added that women constitute a mere 21 per cent of councilors in the 19 countries for which complete data could be obtained.

Nothing is more energizing and empowering than sharing insights and career experiences with other seasoned women leaders. Therefore,


